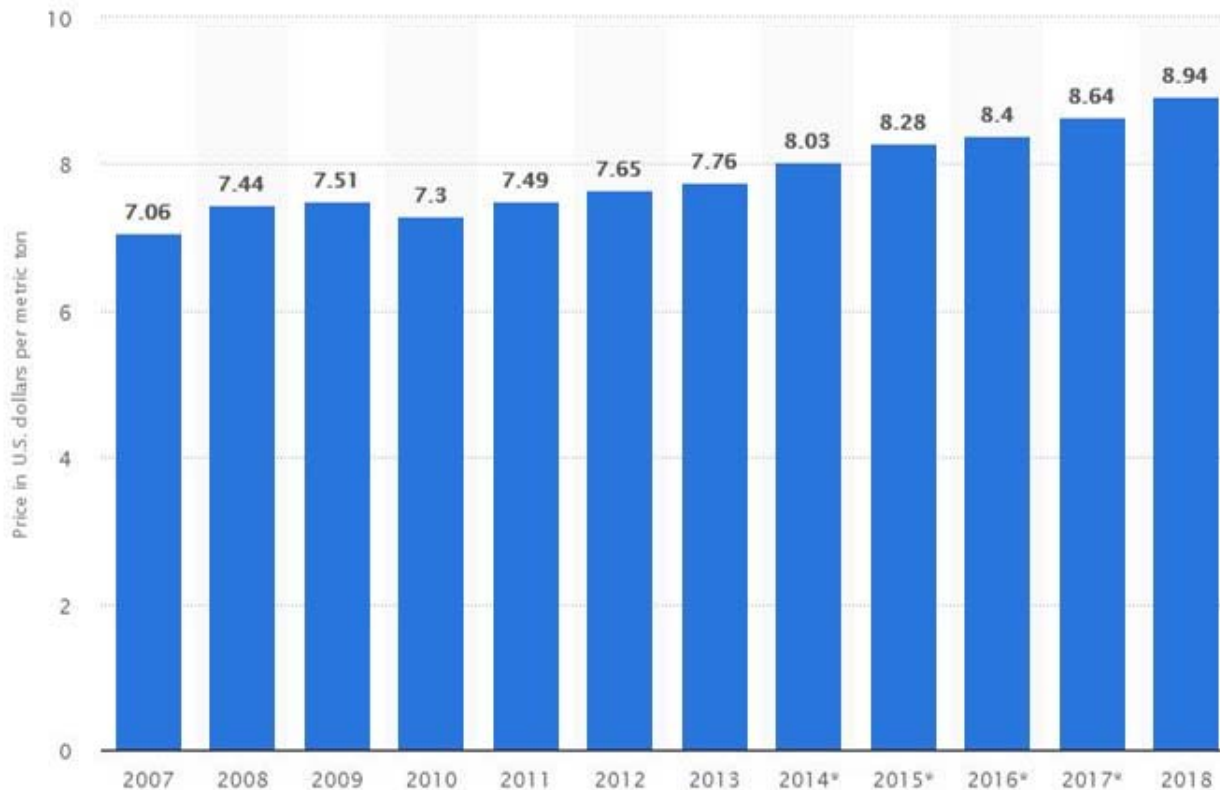


## Average price of sand and gravel in the U.S. from 2007 to 2018 (in U.S. dollars per metric ton)

In the United States, the average prices of sand and gravel is about 8.94 U.S. dollars per metric ton. Regional shortages of sand and gravel which occur in highly populated areas due to reduction in production can lead to these shortages, which in turn produces increased prices in large urban areas. The [U.S.](#) is ranked as the largest producer of industrial sand and gravel, however, the United States Geological Survey (USGS) does note the difficulty in estimating exact data as the definition for sand and gravel differ across
