### ADDENDUM No. 1

RE: Addendum to Request for Quotation (RFQ) RFQ S2024-11 Reverse Osmosis Antiscalant

Bid Due – May 2, 2024, by 2:00 P.M.

#### **Clarification only: This addendum will need to be returned with your bid response.**

This Addendum is and does become a part of the above-mentioned Solicitation. The following questions were received from potential bidders, and the response are provided as shown.

- 1) Who is the current supplier and which product is currently being used?

Answer - Avista Technologies, Inc., Vitec 1000

- 2) What is the current dosage rate?

Answer - 1.0 mg/l

- 3) Price/lb of the current contract?

Answer - \$1.35/lb.

- 4) How many gallons and/or number of 1,200-gallon deliveries were made in 2023?

Answer – For calendar year 2023, four deliveries were made, approximately 500 gallons per delivery, total delivery volume was approximately 2,166 gallons. Although the RFQ indicates typically delivery volumes of 1,200 gallons, deliveries of 500 gallons each were requested in CY 2023 due to overall lower facility production. Facility production is dependent on source availability (surface water and groundwater) and may change from year to year.

- 5) Is it possible to collect our own feed water sample for feed water analysis??

Answer - Yes. If the feed water analysis is going to be performed for the purpose of responding to the RFQ, results must be obtained from a certified laboratory. **Please note that feed water collected, due to specific operating conditions, may not be representative of the average case data presented in Appendix A, which is the data that bids should be based off of.** We can accommodate sample collection Monday through Friday 8 AM to 1 PM. - 6) When will this contract period begin and end?



The contract term would be July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 with four renewal options.  
Please be aware of and review the Demonstration Test section of the RFQ.
